

Tuckahoe Clubhouse Kitchen

Our new kitchen should be complete by the time this article is published. We are installing locks on the cabinets, then everything will be thoroughly cleaned. We are also having one additional rolling island built. The two islands will provide us with lots of storage space and a wonderful ability to configure the kitchen for many different uses.

If you haven't seen the kitchen yet, stop by and take a peek. We now have lots of extra counter and cabinet space. We also have double self-cleaning ovens with a ceramic cooktop. The cooktop has configurable burners, which are terrific. Our new frig is very spacious and we are keeping the old frig in place, as a backup. We also have a dishwasher -- finally!

The clubhouse can be rented by Wintergreen homeowners. The charge is \$75 per event. We now have a fully stocked kitchen (120 plates, 120 bowls/salad plates, 150 small wine glasses, silverware for >140, serving bowls/utensils, cookware/cooking utensils). For an additional \$25 the kitchen dishes, etc. can also be utilized. To check availability go to wtgpoa.org and select 'WPOA Calendar for Pools and Tuckahoe. Once you have selected a date when the facility is available, call Theresa Harris 325-8530 and book your event, then mail Theresa a check for either \$75 or \$100 (if you are also using the dishes, etc) made out to Tuckahoe Clubhouse Fund. If you are paying to use the kitchen dishes, etc, contact Odette Henderson (361-1887) after paying Theresa. Odette will meet you and give you a key, as well as any necessary instructions.
